Seneschal's Missive

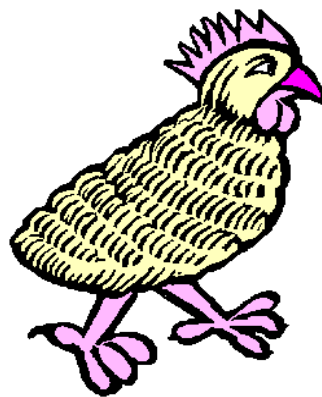
To all who read and hear these words, Kudrun Pilgrim sends greeting.

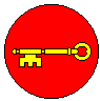

Minutes of the Populace Meeting

July 18, 2010 – Skokke Towers
