# Minutes of the Populace Meeting

June 27, 2011 Myrick Park

Meeting oyezied to order at 6:14.

Vitaliano presented the agenda.

Meeting time -- Since several people have problems with Mondays, we discussed changing the dates of our gatherings to accommodate more folks. After some discussion, it was decided to try to hold Research Night on the first Wednesdays, A&S on the second Thursdays, and Populace Meeting on the third Wednesdays. Each of these dates will be calculated from the first full week, with the week beginning on Sunday. Margaret asked Kudrun if Rokeclif would be willing to host SUN on the second weekend in November. Kudrun did a little preliminary checking. Luckily, Rudivale came through with a viable bid, so we're off the hook for now.

We cleaned out the storage unit! Yay! There's a pile of stuff we don't want -- it needs to go to a garage sale somewhere. The fighter gear went with Ahlwin to check with Toki. Bags for 10x20s haven't been made because Vitaliano needs a needle. (What an opening!) We might want to get a shed in LaCrosse. Robert will call a few places to see if that's viable.

Sewing moot -- this needs to be an all-day affair, probably on a weekend. (Weekend? Not many are open.) This opened the question of what events people are planning to attend. There were six headed to WW, four for Ages of War, Kudrun's going to Novices/Knaves in October and might day-trip Poor Man's Pennsic. We need to have an event in a truck stop.

Cooking Guild -- The group structure will be decided at the first meeting. Maewyn has print copies of Cariadoc's Miscellany and Take a Thousand Eggs or More.

## OFFICER REPORTS

Exchequer -- We have around \$2000 in the checking account. Need to check on what reports have been filed.

Youth -- Not much, but the Youth Get a Castle event is being planned for May.

A&S -- Robert's computer is in a coma. Vettoria will act as his deputy while it is unconscious.

Web -- Someone's going to be taking pictures at our meetings. Bronislava suggested that we make Coronation more visible on the Rokeclif web page. We talked a bit about using facebook for publicizing Coronation (as well as Northshield Great Hall).

Chronicler invites contributions from the populace – recipes from the Cooks' guild, event reports, poetry. Someone suggested the "popup Birch".

Chatelaine – "All of your personalities should be able to shine through."

GAMES EVENT – We're not sure if all the paperwork got sent to the right places. Maewyn & Vitaliano will double check.

## CORONATION

"We got the bid."

Work days are on the calendar on page one. Vitaliano is seeking barley flour. Staffing is coming along. Dahrien will be Hall Steward. Clarissa will be Plating Steward (AKA "Hot Dish"). Ingrid will herd merchants. Vettoria is in charge of troll. Matthias and Amata will work with royals. Brilliana will serve head table. Gavin is the gofer, and will host the postrevel. Misty will coordinate cleanup. (Kitchen cleanup will be done during feast.) We'll be asking Kingdom Officers if they will coordinate fighting, fencing, A&S.

We walked through the event, identifying jobs that will need to be done at what time. More will be done at A&S night, as Bronislava explains some of the duties of retainers, guards, and trollers. We may use radios, but the ankle bracelet for the autocrat is uncertain. Crime scene tape was also discussed. As you can tell, the meeting was getting out of hand, so we put the meeting on hiatus and went to Bronislava's for dinner and talk about the Griffin's Needle Challenge. Kudrun's been helping with garb research.

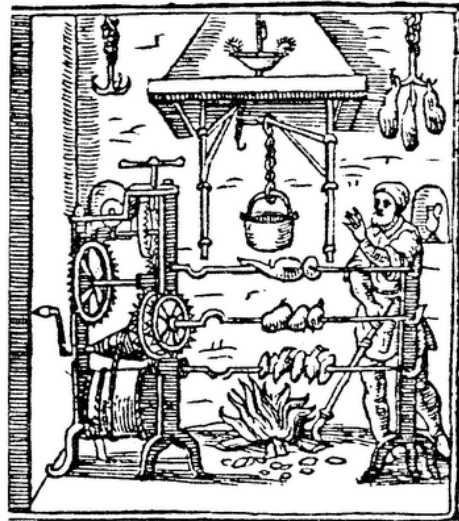
Coronation lunch research (it's a dirty job...)

### Rokeclif Cooks

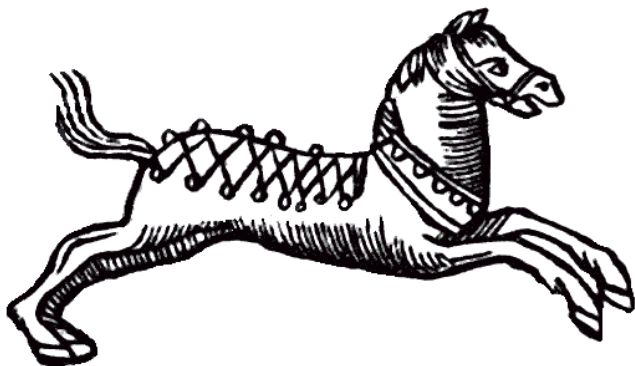

By Bronislavá



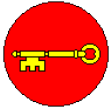
A horse, 'tis said, is nothing but a horse -
